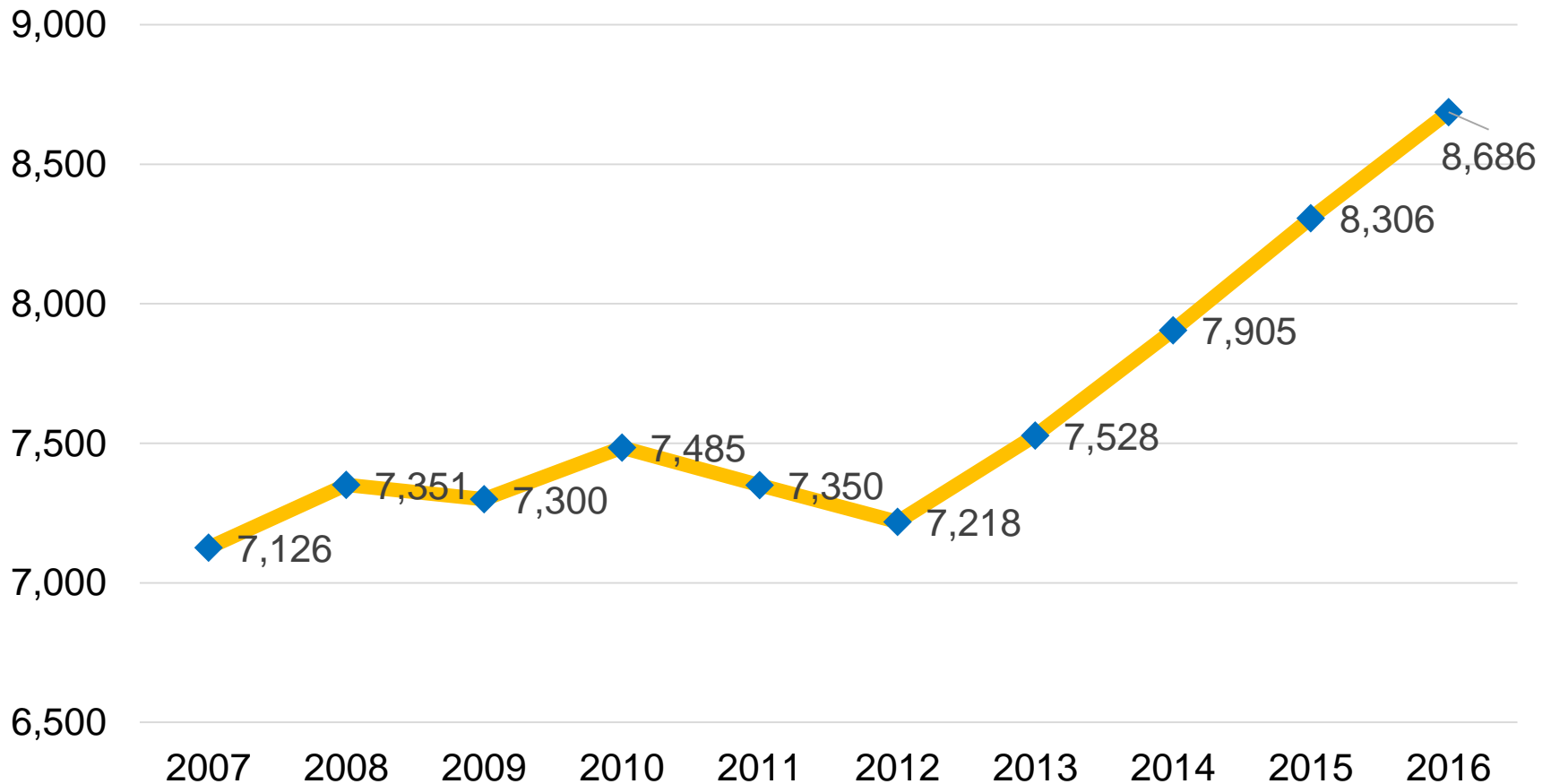
Student Success

6. Enhance career development and alumni/community engagement.

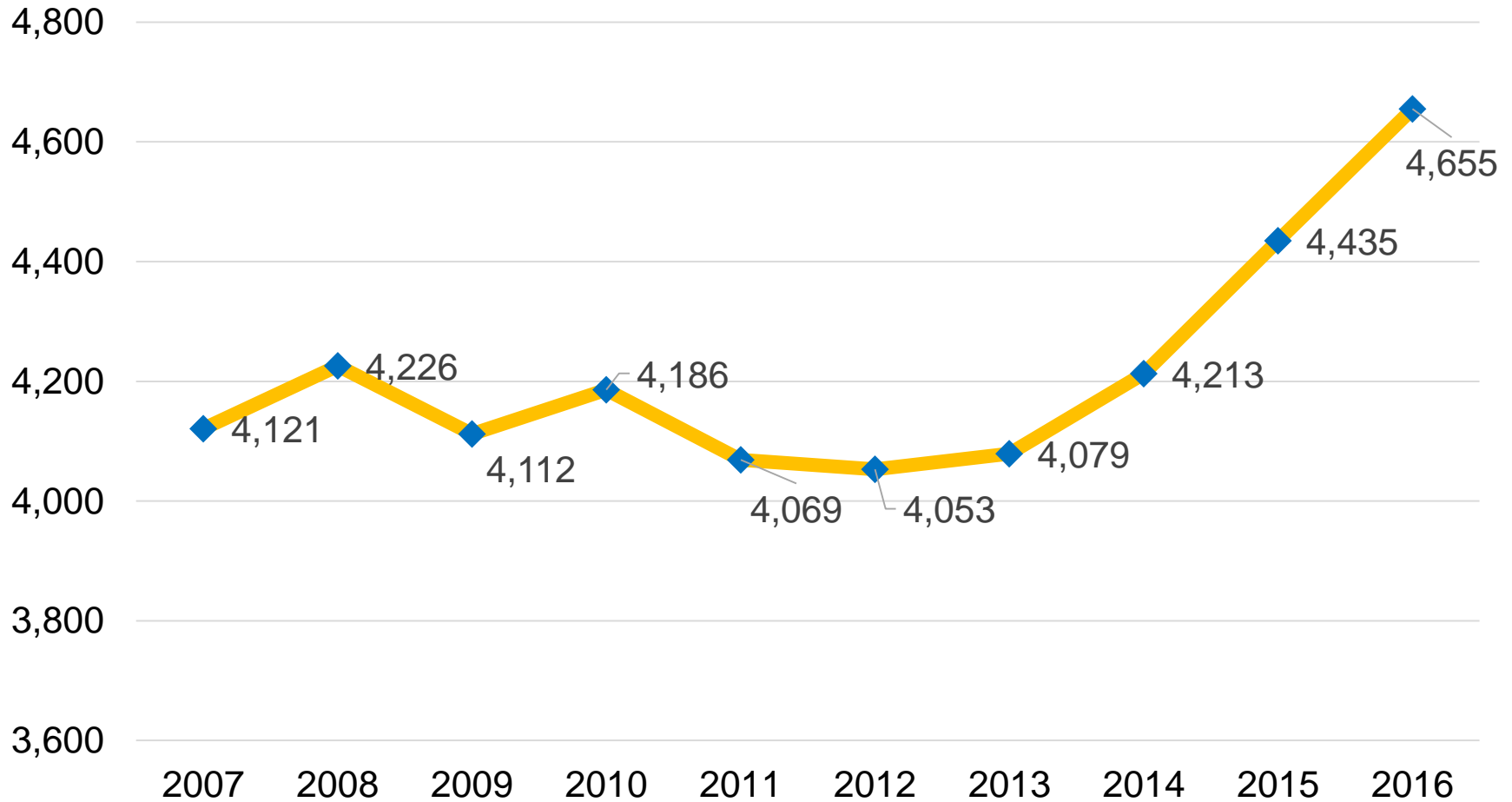
