

## Brian Haynes Named Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs

Dear Campus Community:

I am pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Brian Haynes as UCR's next Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs, subject to approval by President Napolitano. Dr. Haynes currently serves as Vice President for Student Affairs at California State University, San Bernardino (CSUSB). Dr. Haynes' appointment will begin on August 15, 2018.

Dr. Haynes joined CSUSB in 2013 after spending eight years as Vice President and Dean of Students at Clayton State University in Morrow, Georgia. He previously spent five years as a Professor and an Administrator at Florida International University. He has also worked in Intercultural and Student Affairs at East Carolina University and Gettysburg College.

Dr. Haynes received a Ph.D. in higher education from Ohio University, specializing in college student personnel. He has published on a variety of topics in higher education, including African American students and organizations. He presently serves on the NASPA foundation board, and on the advisory boards for the journal Student Affairs Today and for the Inland Valley News.
